ABSTRACT:	<p>The study analyses the formation of public opinion about migration and the migrants. Previous Hungarian research results reveal that the majority of the Hungarians are strongly xenophobic. Using qualitative method and content analysis the study examines the migration campaign of the Hungarian government, the counter campaign of various non-governmental organizations from 2015 and news, blogs, comments on migration appearing in social media, on Facebook from 2015 to the first quarter of 2016.</p> <p>The result shows that the governmental campaign clearly served political goals based on the xenophobic attitude of the Hungarian society with the aim of influencing the public opinion while the counter campaign emerged to make fun of this aim of the government. With describing the migrants only criminals and terrorists the aim of these social media pages is to develop and rouse xenophobia. Creating false rumors, conspiracy theories seems to be another method applied by the tabloid media.</p>

ABSTRACT:	<p>Objectives:</p> <p>The project "Training packages for health professionals to improve access and quality of health services for migrants and ethnic minorities, including the Roma (MEM-TP)" has received funding from the European Union. Project aims to improve access and quality of health services for migrants and ethnic minorities in the EU countries by reviewing, developing, testing and evaluating training of front-line health professionals in migrant and ethnic minority health. Slovakia has been one of the six piloting countries.</p> <p>Methods: The main intention of piloting in Slovakia was evaluation of developed training materials in national context.
